## TOWN OF WELLFLEET BOARD OF ASSESSORS NEW PROPERTY VALUES

The Town of Wellfleet Board of Assessors has completed the revaluation of all real and personal property for Fiscal Year 2021 as required by M.G.L. Chapter 40 Section 56. The Massachusetts Department of Revenue, Bureau of Local Assessment has granted preliminary certification and has authorized public disclosure of proposed values.

New assessed values, which represent full and fair cash value as of January 1, 2020, comply with the Department of Revenue's statistical standards and reflect 2018 and 2019 real estate sales. Value changes ranged from -4% to +4%, with most values staying the same as last fiscal year.

Assessments are on display on the Town's website at www.wellfleet-ma.gov.
