A Message from our President:

The town's Board of Health is meeting on October 12th to begin a discussion to require upgrades to everyone's septic system at differing times to deal with the nitrates that are in our water and watershed. The meeting is hybrid, on <u>zoom</u> and in person, and the agenda is below. There will be another meeting in November that will allow for public comments.

The town is also waiting for the state's Department of Environmental Protection to rule on what has to be done with the 35 cesspools on the Maurice's Campground site that the town will be taking possession of in the next few months. For those of us with older systems (mine predates Title V for example), this will mean we will be facing upgrades in the near, rather than the distant future. The timeline, however, isn't yet set.
